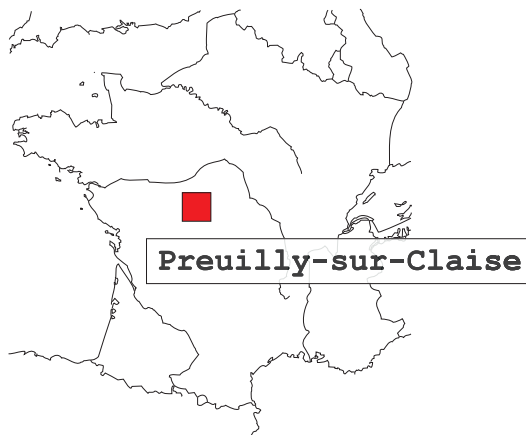

International Colloquium:

The Solutrean
... 40 years after Smith'66

Published 40 years ago, Philip Smith's book (or thesis??) "Le Solutrén en France" (Solutrean in France) still remains the primary reference for the study of Solutrean, because of the volume of information included and the future research directions proposed by the author.

Since this publication, a diversity of methodological approaches has been developed and applied, some following the proposals formulated by Smith. Now seems an opportune time to evaluate the status of Solutrean research, the relevance of the various contributions made since Smith, and to discuss future directions for research.

The goal of this conference is to review the results obtained since the proposals of Philip Smith, with special focus on recent developments of Solutrean analysis. Unlike Philip Smith's "Le Solutrén en France", the review will include all of the Solutrean geographic area: France and the Iberic peninsula.

The sessions will be organized as round-tables during which the participants will present short communications to orient the discussions.

Exhibits of archaeological collections are encouraged, with the participants being invited to present selected artifacts supporting the discussions.
